What treatments are you willing to try? It's important to know whether you're only interested in more natural approaches to conception like IUI, or whether you're willing to try more advanced options like IVF.



What is your budget, and do you have coverage? After your first fertility appointment, our team recommends coming up with a fertility treatment budget. It's also a good idea to know what your insurance will (and won't) cover.
